Vocabulary: **h̄chishno akosh** – you all, the ones who...an action is directed toward

H̄chishno akosh oka h̄chi b̄nna tuk o?

Con conversationally: **H̄chishnakosh oka h̄chi b̄nna tuk o?**

Are you all the ones who wanted water?

H̄chishno akosh h̄sh ia ch̄i h̄o?

Con conversationally: **H̄chishnakosh h̄sh ia ch̄i h̄o?**

Are you all the ones who will go?

Word Meaning: **ia** (e-yah) = go/going

h̄chishno akosh (hah-chihsh-noh ah-kohsh) = you all, the ones who an action is directed toward **h̄o** (hohn) = question marker

con conversationally: **h̄chishnakosh** (hah-chihsh-nah-kohsh)

oka (o-kah) = water

h̄chi (ha-che) = you all

b̄nna (bahn-nah) = want

o (ohn) = question marker

tuk (tohk) = past tense marker

h̄sh (hahsh) = you all

ch̄i (chehn) = future tense marker (from **achi**)

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
