Vocabulary: ilap ako – (him, her, it, them)...an action directed to him, her, it, them

Ilap ako im anumpuli la chi.

I will speak to him.

Ilap ako il i taloa tuk.

We sang for them.

Word Meaning: **il** (ihl) = we

ilap ako (ih-lahp ah-kohn) = him, her, it, them

im (ehm) = to or for him, her, it

anumpuli (ah-nohm-poh-lih) = speak/talk

la (lah) = I **i** (ehn) = to or for him, her, it

taloa (tah-loh-wah) = sing

tuk (tohk) = past tense marker

chi (chehn) = future tense marker (*from* **achi**)
