Ulla pvt nana chima bunna.

This child wants to give you something.

Nanta chima tuk?

What did he give you?

Word Meaning:

vlla (ahl-lah) = child

pvt (paht) = this/these

nana (nah-nah) = something

chima (che-mah) = give you

bunna (bahn-nah) = want

nanta (nahn-tah) = what

tuk (tohk) = past tense marke
