Vocabulary: **tasaha** - scream

Kvta hosh tasaha tuk?

Who screamed?

Ohoyo taseambo mvt tasaha tuk.

That crazy woman screamed.

Word Meaning:

kvta (kah-tah) = who

tasaha (tah-sah-ha) = scream

tuk (tohk) = past tense marker

ohoyo (o-hoh-yoh) = woman

taseambo (tah-sem-boh) = crazy

mvt (maht) = that/those

hosh (hohsh) = subject marker
