

Lesson of The Day

Vocabulary: **ohomba** – to continue raining; to keep on raining

Intensive Form: adding an extra ‘**o-h**’ to the word ‘**omba**’ shows continuous action.

Ninakash ohomba tuk.

It continued to rain last night.

Ohomba na nusi li tuk.

It kept on raining and so I went to sleep.

Word Meaning: **li** (lih) = I

ninakash (ne-nah-kahsh) = last night

ohomba (o-hohm-bah) = to keep on raining

tuk (tohk) = past tense marker

na (nah) = and then/and so/so that

nusi (noh-sih) = sleep
