

Lesson of The Day

Vocabulary: **hochehifo** – keeps reading

Lengthening the base word ‘**hochefo**’ by adding an ‘**h**’ and a nasalized vowel ‘**i**’ changes the verb meaning to show continuous action.

Katie vt anumpa himona hochehifo.

Katie keeps reading the new words.

A hochehifo tuk.

She kept reading to me.

Word Meaning:

vt (aht) = subject marker

anumpa (ah-nohm-pah) = word/words

himona (hih-moh-nah) = new

hochehifo (hoh-che-hihn-foh) = keeps reading

a (ahn) = to or for me

tuk (tohk) = past tense marker
