Nanta ish im atahli tuk?

What did you prepare for him?

Holisso im atahli li tuk.

I prepared papers for him.

Word Meaning: **li** (lih) = I

nanta (nahn-tah) = what

ish (esh) = you

im (ehm) = to or for him, her, it

atahli (ah-tah-lih) = prepares

tuk (tohk) = past tense marker

holisso (hoh-lis-soh) = paper
