Vocabulary: **hopaki** – long ago

Holbvt toba mvt hopaki aminti.

That picture is from long ago.

Hattak mvt illit tok hopaki.

That man died long ago.

Word Meaning:

illit (ihl-liht) = died

holbvt toba (hohl-baht toh-bah) = picture/image

mvt (maht) = that/those

hopaki (hoh-pah-kih) = long ago

aminti (ah-mihn-tih) = from

hattak (haht-tahk) = man

tok (tohk) = remote past tense marker
