

Lesson of The Day

Vocabulary: **anumpuyyoli** – finally speak

Base word – anumpoli – Lengthening the base word ‘anumpoli’ by adding two ‘y’ changes the verb meaning to ‘finally.’

Kvta ish im anumpuyyoli tuk?

Who did you finally speak to?

Alikchi mvt pim anumpuyyoli tuk.

That doctor finally spoke to us.

Word Meaning: **kvta** (kah-tah) = who

ish (esh) = you **mvt** (maht) = that/those

im (ehm) = to or for him, her, it

anumpuyyoli (ah-nohm-poh-yoh-lih) = finally speak

tuk (tohk) = past tense marker

alickhi (ah-lick-che) = doctor

pim (pehm) = to or for us
