

Lesson of The Day

Vocabulary: **pihisa** – keeps seeing

Base word – **pisa** – Lengthening the base word ‘**pisa**’ by adding an ‘**h**’ and a nasalized vowel ‘**i**’ changes the verb meaning to show ‘**continuous**’ action.

Ofi mvt nana pihisa.

That dog keeps seeing something.

Okhissa pit pihisa li tuk.

I kept looking toward the door.

Word Meaning: **ofi** (o-fih) = dog

mvt (maht) = that/those **li** (lih) = I

okhissa (ohk-his-sah) = door

pit (piht) = direction away from the speaker

nana (nah-nah) = something

pihisa (pih-hihn-sah) = keeps seeing

tuk (tohk) = past tense marker

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
