Vocabulary: **bvhanna** – keeps wanting

Base word – **bvanna** – Lengthening the base word ‘**bvanna**’ by adding an ‘**h**’ and the vowel ‘**a**’ changes the verb meaning to show continuous action.

Ulla mvt nanta bvhanna?

What does that child keep wanting?

Ofosik bvhanna.

She keeps wanting a puppy.

Word Meaning:

vlla (ahl-lah) = child

mvt (maht) = that/those

nanta (nahn-tah) = what

bvhanna (bah-hahn-nah) = keeps wanting

ofosik (o-fohn-sic) = puppy
