Nanta ish haklo tuk?

What did you hear?

Nana haklo li tuk kiyo.

I didn't hear anything.

Word Meaning:

nanta (nahn-tah) = what

ish (esh) = you

haklo (hahk-loh) = hear

tuk (tohk) = past tense marker

nana (nah-nah) = anything

li (lih) = I

kiyo (key-yoh) = not
