Vocabulary: **lummasi** – softly/quietly

Ohoyo mvt lummasi hosh taloa.

That woman is singing softly.

Lummasi hosh nowa li tuk.

I walked quietly.

Word Meaning: **li** (lih) = I

ohoyo (o-hoh-yoh) = woman

mvt (maht) = that/those

lummasi (loh-m-mah-sih) = softly/quietly

hosh (hohsh) = subject marker

taloa (tah-loh-wah) = sing

nowa (noh-wah) = walk

tuk (tohk) = past tense marker

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
