Vocabulary: **tahpala** – to shout/yell

Katimi ho Jim vt tahpala?

Why is Jim shouting?

Kvta ish i tahpala tuk?

Whom were you yelling at?

Word Meaning: **ish** (esh) = you

katimi ho (kah-tih-mih hohn) = why

vt (aht) = subject marker

tahpala (tah-pah-lah) = to shout/yell

kvta (kah-tah) = who

i (ehn) = to or for him/her/it

tuk (tohk) = past tense marker
