Vocabulary: **salaha hosh** – slowly

Hosh – manner which usually ends with –ly for adverbial clauses that modify the subject

Salaha hosh anumpuli. Speak slowly.

Ohoyo mvt salaha hosh nowa. That woman walks slowly.

Word Meaning:

salaha hosh (sah-lah-ha hohsh) = slowly

anumpuli (ah-noh-poh-lih) = speak

ohoyo (o-hoh-yoh) = woman

mvt (maht) = that/those

nowa (noh-wah) = walk
