

# Lesson of The Day

Vocabulary: **nusi hosh - sleepily**

**Hosh** – manner which usually ends with –ly for adverbial clauses that modify the subject

**Nusi hosh anumpuli tuk.**

He was speaking sleepily.

**Ulla mvt nusi hosh impa.**

That child is eating sleepily.

Word Meaning:

**nusi hosh** (noh-see hohsh) = sleepily

**anumpuli** (ah-nohm-poh-lih) = speak/talk

**tuk** (tohk) = past tense marker

**vlla** (ahl-lah) = child

**mvt** (maht) = that/those

**impa** (ehm-pah) = eat
