Vocabulary: **washoha ho** – while playing

ho: as/while – for adverbial clauses that have their own subject

Towa washoha ho hottupa tuk.

He was hurt while playing ball.

Ulla mvt washoha ho pisa li tuk.

I saw that child while she was playing.

Word Meaning:

towa (toh-wah) = ball

washoha ho (wah-shoh-ha hohn) = while playing

tuk (tohk) = past tense marker

vlla (ahl-lah) = child

mvt (maht) = that/those

hottupa (hoht-toh-pah) = hurt

pisa (pihn-sah) = saw

li (lih) = I

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
