Vocabulary: **kil impo** – we did not eat

**kil: we** – kil is used before a verb that begins with a vowel (kil impo)

**Omba na kucha kil impo tuk.**

We didn't eat outside because it rained.

**Kil impo kisha.**

We have not eaten yet.

Word Meaning:

**na** (nah) = because

**omba** (ohm-bah) = rain

**kucha** (koh-chah) = outside

**kisha** (kihn-shah) = not yet

**tuk** (tohk) = past tense marker

**kil impo** (kihl ihm-poh) = did not eat

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
