Vocabulary: **takchi ho** – while tying

ho: as/while – for adverbial clauses that have their own subject

Ofi takchi ho nan vltoka yvt vla tuk.

The police officer arrived as he tied the dog.

Ulla yvt shulush takchi ho pisa li tuk.

I saw the child tie her shoes.

Word Meaning:

takchi ho (tahk-chi hohn) = while tying

nan vltoka (nahn ath-toh-kah) = police officer

yvt (yaht) = subject marker **ofi** (o-fih) = dog

tuk (tohk) = past tense marker

vlla (ahl-lah) = child **li** (lih) = I

shulush (shoh-lohsh) = shoes

pisa (pihn-sah) = see **vla** (ah-la) = arrive

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
