

# Lesson of The Day

Vocabulary: **nukhaklo hosh** - sadly

**hosh** - manner usually ends with -ly for adverbial clauses that modify the subject

**Ohoyo mvt nukhaklo hosh anumpuli.**

That woman is speaking sadly.

**Nukhaklo hosh nan vnnoa anoli.**

He is sadly telling a story.

Word Meaning:

**ohoyo** (o-hoh-yoh) = woman

**mvt** (maht)= that/those

**nukhaklo hosh** (nohk-hahnk-loh hohsh) = sadly

**anumpuli** (ah-nohm-poh-lih) = speak/talk

**nan vnnoa** (nahn ahn-noh-wah) = story

**anoli** (ah-noh-lih) = tell

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
