Vocabulary: **hohchvffo hosh** - hungrily

**hosh** - manner usually ends with -ly for adverbial clauses that modify the subject

**Ullosi mvt hohchvffo hosh yaiya.**

That baby is crying hungrily.

**Hohchvffo hosh ula tuk.**

He arrived hungrily.

## Word Meaning:

**ullosi** (ahl-lohn-see) = baby

**mvt** (maht) = that/those

**hohchvffo hosh** (hoh-chahf-foh hohsh) = hungrily

**yaiya** (yah-yah) = cry

**vla** (ah-la) = arrive

**tuk** (tohk) = past tense marker

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
