Vocabulary: **ke** – let's . . . . precedes consonants

**Miko ont ke pisa.**

Let's go and see the chief.

**Shukha nipi, tobi micha banaha ke hoponi.**

Let's cook pork, beans and shuck bread.

## Word Meaning:

**miko** (mihn-koh) = chief

**ont** (ohnt) = go and

**ke** (key) = let's      **pisa** (pih-sah) = see

**shukha nipi** (shoh-kah nih-pih) = pork

**tobi** (toh-bih) = beans

**micha** (mih-cha) = and

**banaha** (bah-nah-ha) = shuck bread

**hoponi** (hoh-poh-nih) = cook
