Vocabulary: **nuna** – to be cooked/done

Tobi micha ahe yvt nuna.

The beans and potatoes are cooked.

Nipi pvt nuna kiyo.

This meat is not done.

Word Meaning:

nuna (noh-nah) – to be cooked/done

tobi (toh-be) = beans

micha (mih-chah) = and

ahe (ah-he) = potatoes

yvt (yaht) = subject marker

nipi (nih-pih) = meat

pvt (paht) = this/these

kiyo (key-yoh) = not
