

Lesson of The Day

Vocabulary: **sakti** – river bank/creek bank

Sakti binili hosh nusi li tuk.

I went to sleep sitting at the river bank.

Ulla tuklo mvt sakti ya anshwa.

Those two children are at the creek bank.

Word Meaning: li (lih) = I

sakti (sahk-tih) = river bank/creek bank

binili (bih-nih-lih) = sit

hosh (hohsh) = subject marker

nusi (noh-sih) = sleep **mvt** (maht) = that/those

tuk (tohk) = past tense marker

vlla (ahl-lah) = child **tuklo** (tohk-loh) = two

ya (yahn) = object marker

anshwa (ahnsh-wah) = dual – to be temporary
