Vocabulary: **nukshobli** – to scare/make afraid

Ofi mvt sv nukshobli tuk.

That dog scared me.

Ulla vhleha ya ish nukshobli nna.

Do not scare the children.

Word Meaning:

ofi (o-fih) = dog

mvt (maht) = that/those

sv (sah) = me

ya (yah) = subject marker

nukshobli (nohk-shoh-blih) = to scare/make afraid

tuk (tohk) = past tense marker

vlla (ahl-lah) = child

ish (esh) = you

vhleha (ah-thih-ha) = plural

nna (nna) = not – follows command to negate
