Vocabulary: **yawa** – to cry/mew

Ninakash katos vt yawa ho haklo li tuk.

I heard the cat crying last night.

Chi katos vt yawa.

Your cat is mewling.

Word Meaning: li (lih) = I

ninakash (nih-nahk-ahsh) = last night

katos (kah-tohs) = cat

vt (aht) = subject marker

yawa (yahn-wah) = to cry/mew

ho (hohn) = marker for focused nouns as non-subjects

haklo (Hahn-kloh) = hear

tuk (tohk) = past tense marker

chi (chehn) = your
