Vocabulary: **shukshi** – watermelon

Hattak mvt shukshi lawa chompa.

That man is buying a lot of watermelons.

Mafo yvt shukshi hokchi bvna.

Grandfather wants to plant watermelons.

Word Meaning:

hattak (haht-tahk) = man

mvt (maht) = that/those

shukshi (shohk-she) = watermelon

lawa (lahn-wah) = a lot

chompa (chohm-pah) = buy/purchase

mafo (mah-foh) = grandfather

yvt (yaht) = subject marker

hokchi (hohk-chih) = to plant

bvna (bahn-nah) = want
