

Lesson of The Day

Vocabulary: **fichak** - dew

Ninakash fichak vt weki tuk.

The dew was heavy last night.

Hvshuk a fichak vt lawa hosh asha moma.

There is still a lot of dew on the grass.

Word Meaning: **weki** (we-ke) = heavy

ninakash (nih-nahk-ahsh) = last night

fichak (fih-chahk) = dew **a** (ahn) = subject marker

lawa (lah-wah) = a lot **vt** (aht) = object marker

tuk (tohk) = past tense marker

hvshuk (hahsh-ohk) = grass

hosh (hohsh) = adverb marker

asha (ahn-shah) = to be there (temporarily)

moma (moh-mah) = still
