Word Meaning: **ont** (ohnt) = go and

oktak (ohk-tahk) = prairie

a (ahn) = subject marker

chukka (chohk-kah) = house

yvt (yaht) = object marker

iksho (ihk-shoh) = none

kvta (kah-tah) = who

hosh (hohsh) = subject marker

pisa (pih-sah) = see

bvna (bahn-nah) = want
