Vocabulary: **hlatvbli** – to spill

Ofi mvt im oka hlatvbli.

That dog spilled his water.

Kvta hosh pishukchi hlatvbli tuk?

Who spilled the milk?

Word Meaning:

ofi (o-fih) = dog

mvt (maht) = that/those

im (ehm) = his, hers, its

oka (o-kah) = water

hlatvbli (thah-tah-blih) = to spill

kvta (kah-tah) = who

hosh (hohsh) = subject marker

pishukchi (pih-shohk-che) = milk

tuk (tohk) = past tense marker
