Vocabulary: **binachi** – to camp

Ninakash katimma ish binachi tuk?

Where did you camp last night?

Bokushi bilika binachi li tuk.

I camped near the creek.

Word Meaning:

ninakash (nih-nahk-ahsh) = last night

katimma (kah-tihm-mah) = where

ish (esh) = you

binachi (bih-nah-che) = to camp

tuk (tohk) = past tense marker

bokushi (bohk-oshe) = creek

bilika (bih-lihn-kah) = near

li (lih) = I
