Note: Underlined vowels indicate that its sound is nasalized.

Word Meaning:

biskinik (bi-ski-nik) = small speckled woodpecker.
It is also the name for our tribal newspaper.*

ish (esh) = you

hochefo (ho-che-fo) = to read

ho (h^onh) = question marker
