Vocabulary: **na kanchi** – vendor(s)

Tushka Homma ya na kanchi yvt lawa chi.

There will be lots of vendors at Tushka Homma.

Na kanchi mvt nanta ittimilaiyuka kanchi.

That vendor sells a variety of things.

Word Meaning: **ya** (yahn) = subject marker

Tushka Homma (tahsh-kah hohm-mah) = literal meaning – red warrior/ also, is a place in Pushmataha County, OK, where the Choctaw gather yearly during the Labor Day weekend to celebrate Choctaw culture.

na kanchi (nah kahn-che) = vendor(s)

yvt (yaht) = object marker

lawa (lah-wah) = lots

chi (chehn) = future tense marker

mvt (maht) = that

nana (nah-nah) = things

ittimilaiyuka (iht-tihm-ih-lay-yoh-kah) = variety

kanchi (kahn-che) = sell

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
