Vocabulary: **achefa** – to wash (something)

Stacy vt ampo achefa tuk.

Stacy washed the dishes.

Colina yvt im ilefoka achefa bvnna.

Colina wants to wash her clothes.

Word Meaning:

vt (aht) = subject marker

ampo (ahm-poh) = dishes

achefa (ah-che-fah) = to wash (something)

tuk (tohk) = past tense marker

yvt (yaht) = subject marker

im (ehm) = his, hers, its

ilefoka (ih-lih-foh-kah) = clothes

bvnna (bahn-nah) = want
