Vocabulary: **vlla** - child

Ulla pvt impa tuk kiyo.

This child did not eat.

Chim vlla yvt katimma ia tuk?

Where did your child go?

Word Meaning:

vlla (ahl-lah) = child

pvt (paht) = this/these (short form of ilvppvt)

impa (ehm-pah) = eat

tuk (tohk) = past tense marker

kiyo (key-yoh) = not

chim (chehm) = your

yvt (yaht) = subject marker

katimma (kah-tihm-mah) = where

ia (e-yah) = go/going
