Word Meaning:

katimma (kah-tihm-mah) = where

ish (esh) = you

atoksvli (ah-tohk-sah-lih) = place where someone works

Chahta (chah-tah) = Choctaw

anumpa (ah-nohm-pah) = language

aiikhvna (eye-ih-kah-nah) = school

li (lih) = i
