Vocabulary: **vlla nakni** – boy **vlla tek** - girl

Ulla nakni mvt towa washoha bvna.

That boy wants to play ball.

Ulla tek pvt towa washoha hinla ho?

Can this girl play ball?

Word Meaning: **washoha** (wah-shoh-ha) = play

vlla (ahl-lah) = child

vlla nakni (ahl-lah nahk-nih) = boy

vlla tek (ahl-lah teek)= girl

nakni (nahk-nih) = male (gender)

tek (teek) = female (gender)

mvt (maht) = that/those

towa (toh-wah) = ball **hinla** (hihn-lah) = can/may

washoha (wah-shoh-ha) = play

bvna (bahn-nah) = want

pvt (paht)= this/these **ho** (hohn) = question marker
