Word Meaning:

ish (esh) = you
pishokchi (pih-shohk-che) = milk
ya (yahn) = subject marker
bahta (bah-tah) = bag; sack
fohki (foh-kih) = to put in

la (lah) = I

chi (chehn) = your

chi (chehn) = future tense marker

<mark>nanta</mark> (nahn-tah) = what

tuk (tohk) = past tense marker
