Vocabulary: **Chahta** – Choctaw

**Chahta chia ho?**

Are you Choctaw?

**A, Chahta sia hoke! Chishnato?**

Yes, I am Choctaw! And you?/How about you?

**Keyu, Chahta sia kiyo.**

No, I am not Choctaw.

**Word Meaning:** **sia** (si-yah) = I am

**Chahta** (chah-tah) = Choctaw

**chia** (chi-yah) = are you      **a** (ahn) = yes

**ho** (hohn) = question marker

**hoke** (hoh-key) = an exclamatory

**chishnato** (chihsh-nah-toh) = and you/how about you

**keyu** (key-yoh) = no      **kiyo** (key-yoh) = not
