I will buy a new hoe.

Chahe pota sv bunna.

I want to borrow a hoe.

Word Meaning:

chahe (cha-he) = hoe

pota (poh-tah) = to borrow

sv (sah) = I

bunna (bahn-nah) = want

himona (hih-moh-nah) = new

chompa (vhohm-pah) = buy/purchase

la (lah) = I

chi (chehn) = future tense marker
