Fvla yvt iti ma anusi.

The crows roost in that tree.

Fvla yvt ofi im illimpa vpa tuk.

The crow ate the dog's food.

Word Meaning: **fvla** (fa-la) = crow

yvt (yaht) = subject marker

iti (ih-tih) = tree

ma (mahn) = object marker

anusi (ah-noh-sih) = roost

ofi (o-fih) = dog

im (ehm) = his, hers, its

illimpa (ihl-lihm-pa) = food

vpa (ah-pa) = eat (item named)

tuk (tohk) = past tense marker

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
