Vocabulary: **hanali** - leg

Ofi mut i hanali yut okpulo.

That dog's leg is broken.

Ofi mut issuba i hanali kopoli tuk.

That dog bit the horse's leg.

Word Meaning:

ofi (o-fih) = dog

mut (maht) = that/those

i (ehn)= his, hers, its

hanali (ha-nah-le) = leg

yut (yaht) = object marker

okpulo (ohk-poh-loh) = broken

issuba (es-soh-bah) = horse

kopoli (koh-poh-lih) = to bite

tuk (tohk) = past tense marker
