Ahe pvt hupi a bvnna.

These potatoes need salt.

Hupi et vma.

Hand me the salt.

Word Meaning:

ahe (ah-he) = potato

pvt (paht) = this/these

hupi (hah-pih) = salt

yvt (yaht) = object marker

iksho (ihk-shoh) = none

et (eet) = a marker appearing before a verb and indicating direction toward a speaker.

vma (ah-ma) = to give me

bvnna (bahn-nah) = want need
