Vocabulary: **shulush** – shoe/shoes

Shulush lusa ilvppvt pisa achukma.

These black shoes are pretty.

Shulush lusa pa chompa la chi.

I will buy these black shoes.

Word Meaning:

shulush (shoh-lohsh) = shoe/shoes

lusa (loh-sah) = black

ilvppvt (ihl-lahp-paht) = this/these

pisa achukma (pih-sah ah-chohk-mah) = pretty

pa (pahn) = this/these (short form)

chompa (chohm-pa) = buy/purchase

la (lah) = I

chi (chehn) = future tense marker

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
