Vocabulary: **impa** – to eat a meal, dine

**Hattak chaha pvt impa bvnna. Chishnato?**

This tall man wants to eat. How about you?

**Keyu impa sv bvnna kiyo.**

No, I do not want to eat.

## Word Meaning:

**sv** (sah) = I

**hattak** (haht-tahk) = man/person

**chaha** (chah-ha) = tall

**pvt** (paht) = this/these

**impa** (ehm-pah) = to eat a meal, dine

**bvnna** (bahn-nah) = want

**chishnato** (chish-nah-toh) = and you/how about you

**keyu** (key-yoh) = no

**kiyo** (key-yoh) = not
