Vocabulary: **ipeta** – to feed (someone)

**Ohoyo mvt vm vlla ya ipeta tuk.**

That woman fed my child.

**Ofi ipeta!**

Feed the dog.

**Ulla pvt hushi ipeta bvna.**

This child wants to feed the bird.

Word Meaning: **ohoyo** (o-hoh-yoh) = woman

**mvt** (maht) = that/those

**vm** (ahm) = my

**vlla** (ahl-lah) = child

**ya** (yahn) = object marker

**ipeta** (ih-pih-tah) = to feed

**tuk** (tohk) = past tense marker

**ofi** (o-fih) = dog

**pvt** (paht) = this/these

**hushi** (hoh-she) = bird

**bvna** (bahn-nah) = want
