Vocabulary: **iksa** – clan, denomination, a Christian

## **Iksa nanta chia?**

What denomination are you?

## **Iksa pia ka okla pikhana chi.**

They'll know we are Christians.

Word Meaning:

**chi** (chehn) = future tense marker

**iksa** (ihk-sah) = clan, denomination, a Christian

**nanta** (nahn-tah) = what

**chia** (che-yah) = are you

**pia** (pe-yah) = we

**ka** (kahn) = conjunction

**okla** (ohk-lah) = they

**pikhana** (pih-kah-nah) = to know us; (pi-ihkana)

**pi** (pih) = us

**ihkana** (ih-kah-nah) = to know
