Possessive Pronoun ᵂm = my

This week's lessons will focus on the –m (ᵂm – my) form of possessive pronouns. Last week, we studied and practiced the use of the –n form (ᵂn – my) or nasalized form. The –m form is prefixed before words that begin with vowels.

ᵂm ofi yᵂt lusa.

My dog is black.

ᵂm alikchi yᵂt McAlester ᵂtta.

My doctor lives in McAlester.

Word Meaning:

ᵂm (ahm) = my **alikchi** (a-lik-chi) = doctor

yᵂt (yaht) = subject marker

lusa (lu-sa) = black **ofi** (oh-fe) = dog

ᵂtta (aht-ta) = live, to reside
