Possessive Pronouns

a -my -nasal form, prefixed before words that begin with a consonant.

vm -my -m form, prefixed before words that begin with a vowel.

ʊm isht ishko homma et vma.

Hand or Give me (in my direction) my red cup.

A holisso apisa ia li tuk.

I went to my school.

Word Meaning:

vm (ahm) = my **holisso apisa** (ho-lis-so a-pi-sa) = school

et (eet) = in the direction of the speaker **isht ishko** (isht esh-ko) = cup

tuk (tuk) = past tense **ia** (e-ya) = to go **vma** (ah-ma) = to give to me

homma (hom-ma) = red **a** (anh) = my **li** (le) = I

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
