Possessive Pronouns

chi = your -nasal form, prefixed before words that begin with a consonant.

chim = your -m form, prefixed before words that begin with a vowel.

Chim illimpa vpa!

Eat your food!

Chim okhissa tiwwi!

Open your door!

Word Meaning:

chim (chim) = your **illimpa** (il-lehm-pa) = food

vpa (ah-pa) = to eat **okhissa** (ok-his-sa) = door

tiwwi (tiw-we) = to open
